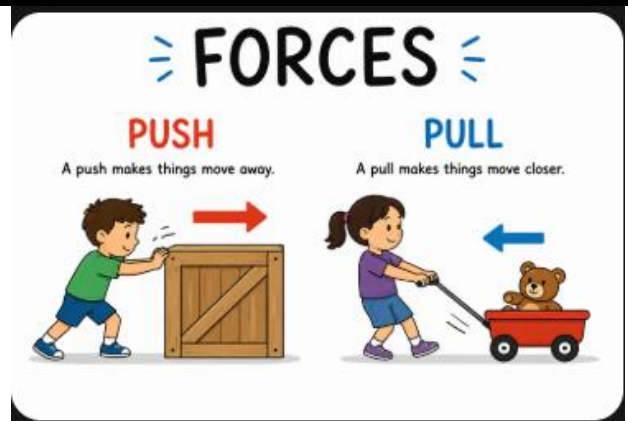

Literacy Activities: Daily - Little Learners Love Literacy

- Reviewing and consolidating Stage 7 phonics and spelling patterns
- Reading and writing words with long vowel sounds and complex digraphs
- Building fluency and confidence when reading connected texts
- Practising decoding strategies to read unfamiliar words independently
- Strengthening comprehension through discussion and retelling activities
- Applying learned spelling patterns and vocabulary in daily writing tasks

Discovery Curriculum: Wednesday

In this unit, students explore how pushes and pulls affect the movement and direction of objects. Through hands-on activities, they identify and categorise these forces, observing how the strength of a force impacts an object's movement. Students investigate real-world examples by experimenting with a toy car launcher, testing how varying forces influence the distance travelled

PE - Mr Milner

Students will perform Cross Country and engage in moderate to high levels of fitness in games and structured Sprinting and Hurdling activities. Tee Ball will be introduced with Catch, Throw, Strike performed in fun modified games.

Music - Tuesday

Students will begin experimenting with composing their own music. They will explore patterns and structure, practise reading and writing rhythm patterns, and use simple techniques to create their own pieces using online programs.

Art: Thursday

In Art this term, students will be exploring the creative process of papier-mâché by designing and constructing their own colourful donuts. Using paper, glue and sculpting techniques, students will build 3D armatures before adding decorative details and painted finishes.
