





Student Absences - How to notify the school if your child is absent:

Xuno – Parent Web Portal or Family App
1.Log in to your XUNO parent portal or XUNO Family app.
2.Via the XUNO web portal: From the School menu click on Attendance, or on the dashboard, click the Attendance Today tile.
Via the XUNO Family app: From the main menu, tap Attendance
3.If you have more than one child at the school, select the name of the child you are reporting an absence for.
4.Click/tap on the Send absence note button
