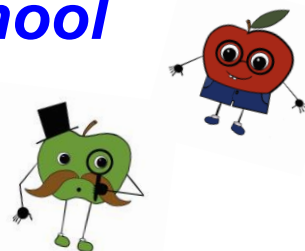

CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

Hi everyone,

This week's wellbeing article located in the Chaplains Corner looks at how parents and care givers can help and support preteens and teenagers respond when they experience strong (& at times overwhelming) emotions and calm down.

"Pre-teens and teenagers often feel and express strong emotions. For example, they might feel angry if something seems unfair, or disappointed if something doesn't turn out the way they wanted. These emotions can be overwhelming. At the same time, because of teenage brain development, teenagers don't always have the skills to think about things rationally.

Learning to calm down is an important part of learning to understand and manage emotions for pre-teens and teenagers."

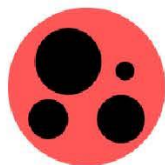

XUNO Family is the school's communication portal for families. All our correspondence is sent through the app. Weekly newsletters, attendance, absence's, teacher communication, school information, all done through our family portal. We encourage all families to use this portal moving forward to ensure all our school community is always up to date with everything happening at HVPS. If you can't seem to get the app working or are unsure on how to use it just give the office a call or pop in at any time and we can assist you.

Student Absences - How to notify the school if your child is absent:

Xuno – Parent Web Portal or Family App

1. Log in to your XUNO parent portal or XUNO Family app.

2. Via the **XUNO web portal**: From the **School** menu click on Attendance, or on the dashboard, click the **Attendance Today** tile.

Via the **XUNO Family app**: From the main menu, tap **Attendance**

3. If you have more than one child at the school, select the name of the child you are reporting an absence for.

4. Click/tap on the **Send absence note** button
