#### Handy Hint

You can submit your child's absent via Xuno.

XUNO allows you to inform the school that your child will be absent on a specific date or time in the future, including today, before or after the roll has been marked. This feature is also available through the Family mobile app.

#### Submitting an absence note

- 1. Log in to your XUNO parent portal or XUNO Family app.
- Via the XUNO web portal: From the School menu click on Attendance, or on the dashboard, click the Attendance Today tile.
  - Via the XUNO Family app: From the main menu, tap Attendance
- 3. If you have more than one child at the school, select the name of the child you are reporting an absence for.
- 4. Click/tap on the **Send absence note** button

### Three-Year-Old Kindergarten available to Mount Alexander families in 2022

Do you know a child who will be three next year?

Every child deserves the opportunity to have the best start. That's why funded Three-Year-Old Kindergarten will be available across Victoria from 2022. This means an extra year of learning, playing and making friends for our children.

Currently, the Victorian Government funds 15 hours per week of kindergarten in the year before school, which is known as 'Four-Year-Old Kindergarten'. From 2022 five hours of funded Three-Year-Old kindergarten will be available, increasing to 15 hours by 2029.

Research shows that **two years of kindergarten are better than one**. And these benefits last into school years and beyond.

Just like with Four-Year-Old Kindergarten, the funded Three-Year-Old Kindergarten program will be tailored to meet the needs of our children and community.

You can visit the kinders during their Open Days, the week of 24th May.

- Castlemaine Kindergarten Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2.15pm-4pm
- Harcourt Pre-School Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 1pm-2pm
- Maldon Pre-School Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> May 10am-1pm
- Newstead Pre-School Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2.30pm -3.30pm
- South Castlemaine Kindergarten Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> May 1pm-3pm

Enrolments for these Kinders are managed by the YMCA. First round offers will commence on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021.

#### Year 6 to Year 7 in 2022 Transition Guidance

#### Support for families

Parents and carers can use the Find my school website to identify their designated neighbourhood government school or closest specialist school options from the residential address they provide.

Two different parent and carer packs are also available to download via the Moving from primary to secondary school: information for parent's web page on the Department's website.

#### Application timelines

Parents and carers need to return the Application for Year 7 Placement 2022 form to their child's government primary school (Harcourt Valley Primary School) by Friday 14 May 2021.

Families of Year 6 students at non-government (Catholic and independent) primary schools may return a copy of their Application for Year 7 Placement 2022 form directly to their preferred secondary school.
