Bring your kindergarten child along to the transition sessions so they can get a feel for the school, meet the teachers and have some fun beginning their learning at school.



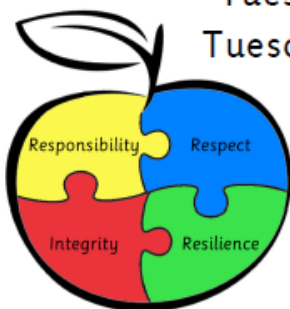
