Principal's Report

End of Term

Well done to everybody on a successful term. It has been pleasing to see students settle into a school routine so early on in the term and establish solid learning habits. Whilst continuing to be COVID Safe, it has been terrific to once again be able to schedule events such as Friday Breakfast Club, Grade 1/2 Camp and Junior School Grandparents and or Special friend afternoon.

Bridging The Digital Divide Initiative

Thank you to the eligible families that returned the correspondence specifying whether they were going to either accept or decline the offer of a digital device as per the BDD terms and conditions.

The next stage will involve the reimaging of the digital devices; netbooks will be reimaged to original Windows 10 Home edition, and iPads will be reimaged to the standard apps similar to what you would have when purchasing an iPad from a distributor. On acceptance of the digital devices, students are not required to bring these to school as replacement devices will be provided. The handover of the digital devices will occur when the school has received the replacement devices.

Please note, as specified in the annual school fee schedule, Grade 3-6 students will continue to be required to pay the annual netbook lease of \$180 per student.

Continuing To Be Covid Safe

The Victorian Government further relaxed its COVIDSafe settings from 6pm on Friday 26 March 2021.

Changes to the COVIDSafe settings include allowing more visitors in the home, changes to mask wearing in some settings and updates to density limits in some settings. There are limited operational changes for schools.

Visitors continue to be welcomed at our school, however face masks must be carried by individuals 12 years and over at all times and worn when physical distancing of 1.5 metres cannot be maintained.

Individuals aged 12 years and over must continue to wear a face mask when on public transport, school buses and when in taxis or ride share vehicles – unless they have a lawful exemption.

Thank you for your understanding and support throughout this term as we continue to implement COVIDSafe practices at our school.
